

RIJKSMUSEUM AMSTERDAM 2024 HIGHLIGHTS AND NEW EXHIBITIONS

What makes the Frans Hals exhibition at the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam a can't-miss event in 2024? Let's kick things off with the big news: the Frans Hals exhibition running from 16 February to 9 June 2024 at the Rijksmuseum is one of the most exciting art events this year. Why? Because it's the museum's first major solo show dedicated exclusively to this Dutch Golden Age master in three decades. Imagine seeing around 50 of his paintings, which is a staggering 25% of all his known works. One of the star pieces, *The Laughing Cavalier*, is making a rare trip back to the Netherlands after over 150 years, visiting from London's Wallace Collection. This alone is worth the trip! What makes this exhibition truly unique is how it's arranged thematically across 10 different galleries. You'll explore Hals' playful and lively depictions of smiles and laughter, delve into family portraits, and even see militia pieces like the *Banquet of the Officers of the St George Militia*. Fun fact: this particular piece has never been loaned out before and comes all the way from the Frans Hals Museum in Haarlem—just a quick 15-minute train ride from Amsterdam for those of you wanting the full Hals experience. . .
