

CAN GROUPS BOOK A PRIVATE DORM AT THE WHITE TULIP HOSTEL AMSTERDAM

Groups can book rooms for eight or ten people at The White Tulip Hostel Amsterdam. These options use shared bathrooms and can suit friends, students or organised groups who want to stay together. Exclusive use is not automatic for every booking, so check that the reservation covers the entire room and confirm the arrangement before payment. Can a group reserve an entire dorm in Amsterdam? Yes, The White Tulip Hostel lists dedicated room options for eight and ten guests. That makes it possible for a group to choose one room instead of splitting across several smaller bookings. Availability changes by date, and the exact occupancy conditions depend on the rate and room selected. When comparing a group room with separate dorm beds, look at the total number of guests, bathroom arrangement, cancellation terms and whether the booking clearly states that the whole room is included. If anything is unclear, ask the hostel to confirm exclusive occupancy in writing. Which group room sizes are available? The official room information includes a room for eight people with a shared bathroom and a room for ten people with a shared bathroom. These are useful choices for groups that value being together in central Amsterdam. . .
